### Jack "Photoshop Wow" Davis' Exploratorium of Photography & Photoshop!

Jack Davis is continually trying something new with his art. Photography is his art and the camera his brushes.

In this presentation Jack will share his experimentations with his "Bat Utility Belt" of camera gear - from infrared to waterproof, from iPhone pictures to motion blur drive-bys. Jack will share not only the What he is currently exploring in his photography, but also the Why —Why "Playing" with your art is so important to keeping the passion alive.



Jack will also share how he sculpts his photography with Photoshop (even the new CS5!!!), and will demonstrate his quick, easy, flexible way to experiment with your own photography — without even opening Photoshop (ACR and/or Lightroom).

#### Biography

Jack Davis is one of the world's leading authors and experts on Photoshop, as well as being an award-winning photographer. Jack is coauthor of the bestselling (a million copies+ in 12 languages) guide to Photoshop, *The Photoshop Wow! Book*, which won many awards (Benjamin Franklin Award for Best Computer Book, Computer Press Association; Best How-To Book, International Digital Imaging Association; Most Useful Book). His latest book, *How to Wow: Photoshop for Photography*, showcases the process of going beyond what was shot to crafting what was experienced.

For over 20 years Jack has been an internationally renowned spokesperson on digital imagery, and routinely teaches at conferences and workshops around the world. He is part of the "Dream Team" at the Photoshop World Conferences and was one of the first inductees into the Photoshop Hall of Fame for his lifetime contributions to the industry.

Jack has an MA and MFA in Digital Imagery, and when he's not in his studio in San Diego, he's usually somewhere in Polynesia, camera in hand, capturing the local color.

### **PRESIDENT'S CORNER** by Barbara Swanson

I've been on the last couple of club photo outings, and have thought about what I've gained from the experiences. What I noticed most was how these outings present a good opportunity to informally learn from others, and that having more eyes to find subjects is very useful.

In general, photography (at least nature photography) is often a solitary pursuit, so having the company of fellow photographers doesn't happen very often. However, being out in the field with others presents some excellent opportunities for hands-on learning. In the Anza Borrego outing, we had a good example of that when one of the members brought a diffuser. A number of people then tried it out with the flowers and experimented with it (until it got coated with cactus spines). Later in the day I overheard someone asking another member if he could look through their viewfinder to see how they were framing a scene. On both outings we shared finding good specimens to photograph, such as lilies and caterpillars. Discussions about equipment came up as well, and it's a good way to see what others are using and whether or not they would recommend a piece of equipment. I find the outings and workshops are a good complement to our monthly meetings, and encourage our members to attend one if they haven't already. 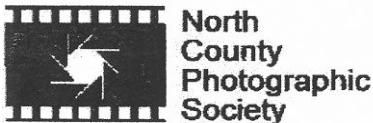
