Kevin M. Connors: Giving Back

Personal projects, especially those that give back, are fantastic ways to further photographic art and craft while offering the photographer riches of the heart that can only come from providing service to others.

The "Veteran: Defending Freedom Project", started by Kevin M. Connors of Coast Highway Photography in March of 2010, is providing dignified portraits of those who've fought for this great country. Currently focusing on World War II and Korean War veterans, Kevin has photographed nearly 50 men and women who have fought and supported America's efforts to defend freedom the world over.

This program will walk you through the process of selecting a personal project, working out logistics, and delivering an artistic vision. You'll be introduced to many of the subjects in the Defending Freedom "Veteran: Project" through their portraits and their incredible stories showing how fulfilling these projects can be to you as a photographer. We'll also discuss how Kevin lights the portraits, prepares and motivates his subjects, and ultimately creates his own custom prints.

Award winning photographer Kevin M. Connors has been creating images for over twentyfive years. From his days as a teenager in his basement working traditional in a darkroom, to today using the latest technologies to create fine art prints 60 inches and larger, Kevin has always believed in the concept of realizing artistic vision and furthering craft by being intimately involved in the creation of his art. Rather than relegate certain steps (retouching, artwork, printing) to professional labs, all of his images are hand crafted in his own studio from beginning to end. Kevin uses time-honored traditions and the latest technologies, hand printing on only the finest papers that can last for centuries.

Spend a few hours hiking through the beautiful forest and mountain meadows of Palomar Mountain State Park located in northern SD County on the west side of Palomar Mountain. The Park is located east of I-15 off Highway 76, up Highway S6, then left on Highway S7 at the junction near the mountaintop. You can get better directions from Google Maps or the Park web site. We will meet at the Silver Crest Picnic Area parking lot, just a short distance from the park entrance. The current plan is to hike a 3.5 mile loop that includes Boucher Lookout and Scott's Cabin site. We will also take a side trip to the Palomar Observatory following the hike for those interested. Cost is \$8 per car to get into the Park. If you want to spend even more time here, I suggest camping Fri and/or Sat (requires reservations, cost \$30). Camping in nearby Cleveland National Forest Observatory Campground is \$15-30; sites are first come, first served. Contact me if you're considering camping.
